• **Code of Conduct for Playing Golf and attending the Clubhouse -update v1.4 23/07/2021**

**Covid Pandemic threat level -0**

### Manage your own risk and act responsibly

- If you have cold/flu like symptoms or loss of taste and breathing difficulties – Do not attend the Golf Club and get your self-tested to protect others.
- Assume that all surfaces are contaminated and sanitise your hands before touching your mouth or face and consuming food & drink – The club have a cleaning programme in place, but you must take the necessary steps to sanitise yourself.
- Wearing Face masks inside the building is recommended to protect you and others, please be polite and courteous if staff or others remind you of your duties, be mindful that others may feel more unsafe than yourself.
- Cover your mouth if you are about to sneeze or cough – this means into your elbow or a tissue, if you use your hands – this is deemed as unsafe so don't do it
- Sanitise your hands on entry to the Club and on your exit
- Observe good social distance as others may be more cautious

### Playing Golf

- Flags and Rakes may be touched but you should sanitize your hands and golf equipment after each round
- Remember that others may be more cautious so respect their personal space and stay 2 metres apart

### In the Clubhouse

- We recommend you wear a mask. This is safeguard staff and other visitor /members please respect others space and do not crowd people not known to yourselves
- Normal bar service has resumed, table service is not provided – this is designed to protect the staff who will remain behind the safety Perspex or may wear a mask if on the customer side
- The Coffee Machine is self service only- please sanitise your hands before and after use
- Observe social distance rules wherever possible
- **Remember you manage your own risk at all times, if you have pinged by the NHS app, have tested positive and/or suffering from the symptoms if Covid-19 . YOU SHOULD NOT ATTEND THE GOLF CLUB**
